

## Lilleshall House.

### LOT 2—*continued.*

#### ON THE FIRST FLOOR

Proceeding to the left from landing at head of staircase, are

SMALL BATH ROOM.

DRESSING ROOM (25ft. × 11ft. 6in.), communicating on the one hand with Dress Closet and the other with W.C. and second Dress Closet.

BEDROOM (26ft. × 26ft.), with window looking South and East, that to East being a bay (14ft. × 4ft.) Mantelpiece in marble, believed to be an "Adam."

These three rooms form separate suite.

BOUDOIR (22ft. 6in. × 12ft.), decorated in Italian style, communicating with

SOUTH-WEST DRESSING ROOM (22ft. 6in. × 11ft.), decorated in old English style; Mantelpiece, also believed to be an "Adam." W.C. enclosed in cabinet, and lavatory basin.

Opening into

BATH ROOM—Porcelain enamelled bath and plated towel airer. Again opening into

SOUTH-WEST BEDROOM (24ft. × 24ft.), decorated in Dutch style; supposed "Adam" Mantelpiece, with window looking South and West, that looking West having a bay of 11ft. × 4ft., communicating with

THE DUKE'S BEDROOM (20ft. × 15ft.) and

DRESSING ROOM, with porcelain enamelled bath, lavatory, cabinet W.C., plated towel airer and porcelain tiled floor.

These six rooms at present form the family suite.

GREEN BEDROOM (22ft. × 20ft.).

BATH ROOM, fitted with porcelain enamelled bath, plated towel airer and W.C.

HOUSEMAID'S CLOSET.

TOWER BEDROOM (21ft. × 12ft.), the walls decorated with stippled work in French grey on oil paint.

COAL STORE.

BEDROOM (21ft. × 14ft. 6in.), opening into

DRESSING ROOM (14ft. × 12ft.).

BATH ROOM—approached by stairway—with porcelain enamelled bath, lavatory, W.C.

*The foregoing are all comprised in the main block of the building. The average height of the rooms is 11 ft.*
