Two Store Closets.

Two W.C.'s.

Corridor, fitted with Cupboards.

TOWER SMOKE ROOM, approached from separate staircase, and opening on to the lead flats of roof, from which the panoramic view obtained of the surrounding country is extremely fine.

Opening from the Central Hall is

MAIN BACK HALL leading to Kitchen entrance, furnished with two staircases leading to landing and corridors, giving access to Bedrooms of North Wing.

In connection with the Main Back Hall is the undermentioned domestic accommodation :—
Telephone Cabinet.

Butler's Pantry (24ft. × 16ft.), with separate Closet, Plate and China Cupboard, Sink (h. and c.) ; Bedroom communicating.

Housekeeper's Room (20ft. × 15ft. 6in., 11ft. high).

Steward's Rooms (24ft. × 6ft, 15ft. × 6ft.).

Chef's Room.

Kitchen (38ft. × 19ft. × 16ft.), fitted with "Eagle" Range, Carron Central French Range, and serving hatch.

Two Larders (22ft × 14ft. × 14ft.).

Scullery (20ft. × 15ft. × 14ft.).

Cold Store (14ft. × 6ft. × 11ft.).

Still Room (19ft. × 15ft. 6in.), with "Eagle" Range and fixture Cupboards.

House Steward's Office (12ft. × 11ft.).

Still Room Store.

Housekeeper's Store (14ft. × 8ft.).

Plate and China Room (13ft. × 14ft.).

Servants' Hall (20ft. 6in. × 15ft.).

A flight of stairs leads from domestic offices to—

Three Servants' Bedrooms.

Housemaid's Sitting Room.

Bathroom and W.C.

IN THE BASEMENT OR LOWER GROUND FLOOR

are Beer Cellar, Mineral Water Cellar, small Wine Cellar, Wood and Coke Cellar, Strong Room, Flower Room with door to Colonnade, Brushing Room, Boot Hall, Heating Chamber with two Boilers supplying bath water for main block, two Footmen's Dormitories (eight beds), Bathroom with fitted bath and four lavatory basins (h. and c.), Binned Wine Cellar, Battery Cupboard, Electrician's Workshop, and Gun Room fitted with Cupboards.

The Basement, which is heated by hot-water pipes, is stone paved, and is perfectly dry, light and airy.

IN THE KITCHEN YARD are two Servants' W.C.'s, Coal Yard and Plumber's Shop.

HEATING AND HOT WATER SUPPLIES.—The Ground Floor of the House and Corridor in the North Wing are heated by hot water. The hot water supplies are derived from three independent boilers in the House and one large boiler outside.

LIGHTING.—The entire premises are lighted by electricity from the private plant hereafter described.

DRAINAGE AND SANITARY ARRANGEMENTS.—These are believed to be in perfect condition, and are subjected to tests every six months. All the sanitary and ventilation pipes open on to an air shaft in the centre of the main block, and the outfall is into open beds beyond the Abbey Woods, nearly a mile from the residence.
